3. Minutes of Previous meeting

7. Highways / Neighbourhood Services & NLC issues

Concern was again raised about parking near the new housing development on Main Street and the Parish Council felt it was disappointing that NLC Highways had not replied to emails regarding this. Cllr Norman Smith raised the state of Sheepdyke Lane, including potholes and block sinkholes. Road sweeping is required on the hill too. Clerk to report these to NLC.

8. Planning

The Council discussed the following applications:

PA/2014/0304 – Overhead lines re-submission. The Parish Council had no further comment to make on this.

The outcome of **PA/2014/0786** – Hall Meadow was received after the agenda, the Parish Council were pleased to note that permission had been refused.

It was unanimously agreed that up to £1000 would be spent on Bonby Day, but all hoped that the final total would be less than that. Detailed spending within that budget would be proposed and agreed in forthcoming meetings.
