## Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting

Minutes of the meeting of Bonby Parish Council held at 7pm on Monday 3rd September 2018 at the Village Hall, Bonby.

### **Public Comment**

Biowaste representatives attended the meeting and outlined as yet un-submitted plans for the site. This will include a bio filter application for the eastern side of the site. When raised by the PC, Biowaste assured that landscaping will resume when there is more rain. The state of the road was again raised by the PC.

### **3. Minutes of Previous meeting**

The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on Monday 16th July 2018 with the agreed matters of accuracy were approved and signed as a true and correct record.

### **4. Clerk's Report**

The Clerk asked the council about the poppy planting and if there was a chance of them still flowering after the extremely hot and dry summer. Cllr Harriman was hopeful that if there was rain and a mild autumn they may still flower. It was simply unforeseen and unfortunate that there was extreme weather and the planting spot could not be watered.

### **5. Police Matters / Neighbourhood watch / NATs**

There was a distraction burglary in early August. There is an issue with speeding cars on Middlegate Lane. The Clerk will place a request for volunteers for Neighbourhood Watch on the website and in the Low Villages News. The Clerk will invite the Humberside Police Commissioner to a future meeting with the PC and local residents.

### **6. Report from Local Councillors**

Cllr Carl Sherwood gave an update. The Bonby to Saxby section of the Ancholme Path is nearly finished. Cllr Harriman raised the issue of Carr Lane again - many cars are now using it exacerbating existing problems. The Parish Council also raised concern about the dangerous state of St Andrew's Place – if ONGO continued to leave it in the state it is in can NLC repair it and bill ONGO?

### **7. Highways / Neighbourhood Services & NLC issues**

The PC raised the following with the Ward Cllrs:

- Dangerous state of footpath in St Andrew's Place. A resident had fallen causing injury.
- Ongoing issues of Carr Lane, Sheepdyke Lane, Church Lane etc.

### **9. Parish Paths Partnership**

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The Parish Council unanimously voted against joining the Parish Paths partnership. This will however be reviewed in the future.
