Report from Ward Councillors

- a) Cllr Rob Waltham gave an update stating that North Lincs had received £5.5mil in UK prosperity funding from the Government, and that NLC would be looking to distribute this in the form of many smaller grants to communities.
Nominations for Community Champions opened on 16th June, and will close on 30th September.
A new web service has been launched – Live Well North Lincs – that is a hub for help with improving health and fitness and information on activities and events across North Lincolnshire.
Free swimming sessions for under 16's will be available at all NLC leisure centres from 25th July to 4th September.
Changes have been made to the Just Go service to zone busses and improve access.
