#### **Minutes of Previous meeting**

- a) The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting, both held on Monday 3th July 2022 were reviewed and agreed as an accurate and true record and signed accordingly.

**22/23 – 0904**

#### **Report from Ward Councillors**

- a) Cllr Sherwood gave an update stating that NLC had purchased a pothole repair machine which was able to repair potholes four times faster than a manual team, utilising a cut and fill method which would give a better result.  
The free swimming sessions at leisure centres had been popular, and over 3,000 children attended over the Summer months.  
Five parks in North Lincolnshire had been awarded Green Flag status.  
NLC has received £4mil shared prosperity funding from the Government.  
Fifth vaccines were being rolled out for over 50's and care home staff.  
There will be a Jobs Expo, held at Baths Hall on 21<sup>st</sup> September  
The Discover Event for families of children aged 5-12yrs would be held on 24<sup>th</sup> September at venues across Scunthorpe  
There were currently issues with bin collections due to a driver shortage, priority being given to general waste collections.

**22/23 – 0905**

#### **Highways / Neighbourhood Services & NLC issues**

- a) Councillors again raised issues with drainage and poor surface on Sheepdyke Lane.  
b) No other highways issues were raised

## 22/23 – 0907 Planning

## 22/23 – 0908 Village Environment

- a) Councillors discussed setting up a Green Team to assist with planting around the Village, agreeing that this would be very beneficial, and would be supported by the Parish Council.
- b) The Clerk reported that English bluebells, snowdrops and crocus bulbs had been ordered, with arrival expected in Late September.
- c) Councillors discussed the Orchard, the Clerk updated that the new had been ordered and was awaiting delivery.  
Cllr Hurcombe stated that she wished to work to identify the trees that had been planted in the Orchard and identify those that had not successfully grown.  
Resolved – Councillors resolved a £10 budget for obtaining tags to mark those trees that required replacement.
- c) The Clerk reported that a meeting was scheduled for later in the week with NLC to discuss the trees on the Gilman Trail.
- d) Councillors discussed the Playing Field and the Clerk updated that mole control on the playing field was further delayed due to the lack of rain.
  - i) There was no update on progress with Bonby Playing Field Association
  - ii) Councillors discussed the request and quote for cutting the Playing Field Hedge. It was confirmed that the hedge belongs to Ongo and not the Parish Council, so there would be no further action on this matter.
