Purpose

All major emergencies will be dealt with by emergency services, local authorities, utilities and voluntary agencies in a combined response. The Emergency Plan is not intended to be a substitute for these services and, on an emergency situation arising, the first action should always be to contact the emergency services by **dialling 999**.

The purpose of the plan is to cater for extreme circumstances (for example heavy snowfall) that might prevent the emergency services from reaching the scene immediately. In such cases the initial response may rely entirely on Bonby residents; this plan describes how such an initial response will be co-ordinated.

Initial Actions

If an emergency arises and it is not possible to contact the emergency services straight away (or if their response may be delayed) the Bonby Emergency Plan should be initiated as follows:

1. Contact the *Emergency Co-ordinator*
