NLC is looking at a support scheme for over 66's in the area, that will be similar to last year, with air fryers for those that did not receive them, and slow cookers for all over 66's. Updating on Bonby Lane, a meeting has been scheduled with Highways Officers and Bioganix to discuss timing of remedial works, as this will require the road to be closed to all traffic for a period. Ward Councillors drew attention to the planning application for a large data centre at Elsham Wold.
