26/27 – 0604 Report from Ward Councillors

Councillors Carl and Nigel Sherwood updated Council on the following:

Over 1,000 residents have received a £300 grant to help with the cost of heating oil. There is a also £100 grant available towards the cost of LPG, but you have to prove that it is for a domestic residence.

On average, 200 fixed penalty notices for litter and PSPO's of £70-£100 are issued each month.

Councillors also discussed that further works to Bonby Lane were scheduled for later in the Summer.
